The physical agility and written testing will be conducted on **April 1**st **2023**. Written testing will be completed at the Coplay Borough Municipal Building, 98 S. 4th Street, Coplay, PA at 9 a.m. Valid photo identification (i.e., driver's license) will be required for admission to the tests. Only those who have submitted a completed application, along with the application fee by the deadline, will be allowed admittance. Physical agility will be held at the Whitehall High School, 3800 Mechanicsville Road, Whitehall, PA at **12:00 p.m. same day.**

Following successful completion of the testing process, interviews will be held on **May 4**th **and May 5**th **2023**.

To apply for a position as police officer, a person must be a citizen of the United States, must be at least 21 years of age, must be a high school graduate or possess a General Equivalency Diploma (GED), must possess a valid Pennsylvania Driver's License and **MUST BE ACT 120 CERTIFIED** and maintain said certification. Successful applicants must pass the written examination, physical agility examination, oral interview, psychological examination, background investigation and medical examination including drug testing. Polygraph testing may be waived if requirements are met.
