Council President led pledge of allegiance:

Hearing of person: -Barry Kibler complained about parking concerning pickleball parking. He was informed there are many signs that show people where parking is.

PWD Boyle- Normal operations, pickleball courts open, Multimodal grant underway, Tiffany working with team to address construction easements.

BCO Helman- \$5,563.00 in permits, Problem with cats under the bridge, asked Public works to remove all the items including houses and food bowls. Lehigh County would have to be called since it's their property. Mr. Kern asked who he would have to contact at Lehigh County and was instructed to contact General Services.

Chief Emerich- \$428 collected fines, 30 warning 34 verbal 29 tickets 38 traffic citations, 335 incidents, 12 arrests. Full staff, bikes are finished, officers will have to take bike training for insurance purposes. Grohotolsky said it was good to see Officer Araujo at the St. Pete's picnic.

Asst. Fire Chief Buchfuhrer – 27 incidents 16 in Borough 11 mutual aid.

Benson – approval of block party, filled out all information and application. Requesting Hall to Coplay streets be blocked off. Lexi Bundra asked about holding Zumba at the Social Hall, open for discussion. All council received email about Coffee & conversation on September 9th @ 10AM. Social Hall will be closed this weekend for floor maintenance from Pipe break.

Discussion of any problems/matters: Received traffic report from Acela, No stop sign warranted, they advised of other recommendations such as bump outs, plastic removable speed bumps.

Hermany – Pool going well, few hiccups, Pickleball open, music at Gazebo going well.

Dee – discussed closing the pickleball courts at dusk due to any possible vandalism. Police should not have to worry about opening and closing, look at getting cameras. Trail usage for July – 11,761 cyclist and pedestrians. Sunday is still the busiest day at 10:30AM. Complaints about ebikes, look into ordinance, state laws and enforcement is issue. LSA grant for Durango police vehicle.

Santoroski- Mr. Boyle covered most everything, Public Works, Multimodal, Grants and Greensway was submitted.

Grohotolsky – Utility Trailer moved, Mr. Luckenbach sold it.
